

BOARD OF SELECTMEN
Meeting Minutes

April 22, 2019

CALL TO ORDER: Sonny opened the Meeting at 7:05PM with the flag salute.

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

MINUTES:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the minutes for April 16. Dottie **second**. **All** were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Joe Parsons, Rec Director, gave an update on the dance classes and said that he wanted to start thinking about swim classes. Steve Malmude made a comment about the price being too high and that he could give the lessons for less. Sonny made the suggestion that they could get together and discuss it.
- Jason Johnson, Fire Chief, asked about the policy he had sent and said he would resend it after Wendy showed him that she did not receive all of it. Sonny asked about the trucks and ambulances and Jason said that the whole fleet should be done by Wednesday and the ambulances are getting fixed. The Board said that they would like to get the appointment papers done next Monday and that they need the certifications. For the Fire Department ordinance the Board decided to put it off until the 29th of April.
- Dottie read the report for the fundraiser held by the 2020 Block Party on Saturday.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

- Megan Eaton spoke about the buildup of stone dust from the sanding of the roads this winter that had ended up on her lawn. Sonny told her that this winter we had a lot of ice and that the Road Commissioner does some cleanup of areas that need it. Bill Jones made a comment about the buildup of stone dust being everywhere in Limerick.

- Joanne **motioned** to put insurance on 62 Washington Street. Wendy **second**. **All** were in favor.
- Sonny read the list of people who still need to come in and get sworn in.
- Wendy made a comment about the appointment papers and that people should be contacted before they are appointed. Judy asked about the Tibbetts Park Revitalization Committee and Joanne said that it had combined with the regular Tibbetts Park Committee. Wendy **motioned** to appoint the Handicapped Accessibility Committee and Tibbetts Park Committee to the names mentioned. Dottie **second**. **All** were in favor.
- The Board scheduled the Peppermill Liquor License renewal Public Hearing for May 6th at 7:00PM and to put it in the paper.
- The Board discussed the Code Enforcement June ballot changes for fees and Sonny asked where the numbers came from. Dottie said that they are lower than other places and Joanne said that everyone should have a copy of it. The Board put it off until next week.
- The Board talked about the County Budget Committee Caucus and how someone should go to vote to have Dean LePage be the person to represent the town and if not they will put Dean down to represent Limerick anyways.
- Joanne **motioned** to sign the reclaim deed without covenant and this is on map 3 lot 2. Wendy **second**. **All** were in favor, except for Dottie.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the warrant as written. Joanne **second**. **All** were in favor.

HEARING OF THE CITIZENS:

- Sue McIntyre made comments about the Budget Meeting being changed from April 25 to May 2. She also asked about how many committees there were and if there is a schedule for when they come in. Sonny told her that the Board leaves it up to the committee to come in and give the updates. Steve Malmude also made a comment that the committees should be answerable to everyone in the town. Wendy said that with her being on committees they come to the Board when they have the information gathered. Judy made a comment about the committees and that they are not getting tax dollars and that some of the people who had been appointed hadn't been asked.
- John McIntyre asked about the presentation on capital improvements and when that was and Wendy told him that it had been at 6:00 before the regular meeting and told him that it was broadcasted.
