URGENT COVID-19 UPDATE – OUTBREAK - #6 Pickle Line

All Pickle Line Employees – Salaried and Bargaining Unit

Today, the Haldimand-Norfolk Public Health Department declared the Pickle Lines (#6 Line) at Lake Erie to be an “outbreak” area for the COVID-19 Virus. Simply, the reason it is classified as an “outbreak”, is that we currently have 2 consecutive Pickle Line employees who have tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. All employees identified by the Haldimand-Norfolk Public Health Department as having been in “close contact” with infected employees have been notified and are required to comply with the Public Health directive to self-isolate for 14 days.

The Haldimand-Norfolk Public Health Department has recommended that all employees who worked at #6 Pickle Line on/after October 18th should arrange to be tested for COVID-19 as a precautionary measure. Once tested, employees will not be required to self-isolate but will need to self-monitor for symptoms.
