

PRIVACY POLICY

1. WODL only collects personal information when you give it to us voluntarily, for example, by filling out a form or survey. Personal information is used by us in order to provide our programs and services to you.
2. WODL does not sell or lend your information to any third-party marketing group. If ever we share information with an outside organization in order to provide a program or service to you, we ensure they comply with the same strict privacy controls that we use ourselves.
3. We may gather information about traffic on our website so that we can continue to develop the site better to suit your needs. This does not include personal information about you, but includes information about your visit on the site such as:
 - a) The name of your internet service provider, its IP address and the name of your service provider's service.
 - b) The length of each visit
 - c) The number of requests per visit
 - d) Your type of operating system (Windows, MacIntosh, Unix, etc.)
 - e) Your browser type (Netscape, Internet Explorer, etc.)
4. Canadians are protected by two federal privacy laws, the Privacy Act and the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA). PIPEDA is based on the Canadian Standards Association's Model Code for the Protection of Personal Information, which is incorporated into the legislation. Organizations in Quebec are subject to the Quebec private sector privacy law. Oversight of the law is in the hands of the Commission d'accès à l'information.
