MEMBER'S GUIDE- PHOTOGRAPHY SHOWMANSHIP

- 1. Members to use photo display board to explain the techniques used and skills learned as a part of their unit work.
- 2. Members are not required to explain all of the photos on their display board for Showmanship. Members should focus on the photos that pertain to the skills being learned and exemplified according to the respective unit(s) the member is enrolled in and the criteria of the scorecard.
- 3. If the member is enrolled in more than one photography unit, they only need to complete one display board and showmanship class that represents all their photography work across the units. Showmanship should be completed with other photography members from the same age group, regardless of which unit they are enrolled in.
- 4. Members should note that there is a maximum size for the display board, shown below. Member's are permitted and encouraged to be creative in the size of their display photos, the configuration of the board, and the materials used to create the display board.
 - Maximum Height:120 cm (maximum height of the display panel)
 - Maximum Length: 180 cm (maximum width of standing display panels)
