## 85<sup>th</sup> PROVINCIAL WINTER FAIR RULES AND REGULATIONS – 2023 4-H HORSE DIVISION



- 1. All 4-H Horse Club Members participating in PWF must have their horses in the barn before 8:00 PM on the Thursday evening of the fair.
- 2. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning his/her stall at the end of the show.
- 3. There will be an entry fee of \$60.00 (plus Tax) per member, and an exhibitor fee of \$10.00 per member (plus Tax).
- **4.** Entry fees, less a \$15.00 office charge, will be refunded if a veterinarian certificate is received at the office within 48 hours of the beginning of the Fair.
- 5. All 4-H Horse Club members must use their achievement project in order to participate in the Provincial Winter Fair.
- 6. In order to qualify for aggregate at Provincial Winter Fair, each horse exhibitor will be required to:
  - a) Participate in Horse Judging
  - b) Participate in Horse Showmanship
  - c) Participate in his/her registered unit classes. (Including trail, pleasure and equitation in order to accumulate his or her aggregate scores). \*\*Amendments, at the discretion of the Horse Rep, to be considered with regards to safety of members.
- 7. Each exhibitor shall be responsible for having his or her animal ready when a class is called.
- 8. All animals entered at PWF may be used for judging classes and for Round Robin Competition. This is a condition of entry. NO EXCEPTIONS, unless authorized by the Horse Rep If the owner, leader or club representative is not present at the stall area, the Division Rep/Round Robin Committee has the right to safely remove the animal from its stall for the purpose of Round Robin or Judging Competitions.
- 9. A Reminder that the horses used for Round Robin will be the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> placings from the Showmanship semi-finals in each age division: Junior, Intermediate, & Senior. Any substitutions must go through the Horse Rep and one other "A" leader. Alternative horses may be used at the discretion of the PWF Committee.
- 10. No exhibitor may talk to the Judge during the judging of a class, unless asked a specific question by the Judge.
- 11. All decisions on these rules shall be made by the Provincial Winter Fair Grievance Committee and shall be considered final.
- 12. All Dress, Tack & Equipment requirements are as per BC 4-H rules.
- 13. It is mandatory for every club entered in PWF to enter one team in their division's Show & Fitting provided they have an eligible member, (Senior over 13 yrs of age regardless of JR. Proficiency) and these Show & Fitting points will count towards Club Aggregate points. [Not Available in 2023]
- 14. Each horse club entered must provide two volunteers (parents) to help as needed, with the events at Provincial Winter Fair. Names to be submitted with entries.
- 15. No dismantling of stalls prior to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday. If stalls are dismantled, the offending club will be fined \$100.00.
