



Changing your furnace filter will save you money.

Have you checked your furnace filter lately? In Alberta it is recommended that you inspect your furnace filter every 30 days. This is especially true if you have any pets.

Regularly changing your filter will result in savings and less headaches. Clogged/ dirty furnace filters place more strain on the blower motors, and cause for the blower motor to run more frequently. It is also important that you install the furnace filter in

the proper direction for proper air flow.

I have been asked many times, "which filter do I recommend? "

Buy the pleated filter, because you care about the air you and your family is breathing and as well you will reduce the amount of dust that collects in the home. Also be sure to purchase the correct size for your furnace.
