DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Joanne Andrews-Transfer Station, - As A Reminder – If you can bring your Christmas wrapping paper and boxes to the transfer station for recycling please do. It will save the town money from having to take it to ecomaine and pay tipping fees.
- Cindy Smith-Library report for November. The Library has an Adult Book discussion and a Teen Book discussion. The next Teen Discussion will be January 6th and you can pick up the book at the Library. There will be a Book Discussion will be January 9th, 2017 on the book, Zeitoun. - **A Motion was Made and Seconded to hold a Special Town Meeting** on January 17, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. for the town to vote on a Moratorium regarding Recreational Marijuana. **All were in favor.**

- The Board of Selectmen reviewed bids for the Rebuilding of the Rock Wall at the Tibbetts Memorial Park. The Town received two (2) bids, one for \$41,575.00 and one for a minimum of \$43,564.00-but not to exceed \$45,742.20. The Select board will give these amounts to the Budget Committee, and a **Motion was made and seconded** to approve a warrant article for the amount of \$43,000.00. **All were in favor.**
- The Board of Selectmen signed insurance renewal forms for Paquin & Carroll in the amount of \$26,186.00 for the upcoming year. A note will be sent with the renewal informing P&C that a new inventory is being done with all departments and the Select board will contact them as to any changes that might need to be made.
