

BYLAW No. 1063

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CASTOR, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING AN INTERMUNICIPAL
COLLABORATION FRAMEWORK WITH THE COUNTY OF PAINTEARTH No. 18.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 708.28 of the *Municipal Government Act (MGA)*, *Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto*, provides that two or more Councils of municipalities that have common boundaries must, by each passing a bylaw, adopt an intermunicipal collaboration framework to:

- a) provide for the integrated and strategic planning, delivery and funding of municipal services; and
- b) to steward scarce resources efficiently in providing local services; and
- c) to ensure municipalities contribute funding services that benefit their residents.

AND WHEREAS, The Council of the Town of Castor wishes to adopt an intermunicipal collaboration framework with the County of Paintearth No. 18.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Castor, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

That the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between the Town of Castor and the County of Paintearth No. 18, attached as Schedule A and forming part of this Bylaw, be hereby adopted.

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect when it has received third reading and has been duly signed.
