Submissions will be accepted up to Saturday, July 15, 2023 at 4pm. (NO EXCEPTIONS)

Artwork must be hand delivered to the Public Art Centre during operational hours.

Artworks must be accompanied by a completed entry form and exhibition labels along with payment. The Public Art Centre is **NOT** responsible for loss or damage to any artwork, no matter the cause.

By signing the entry form, you agree to the terms and requirements and give the Public Art Centre consent to use the images to advertise and promote the exhibition.

The Juror's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Notification will be made via email prior to the artist reception.

Any artwork not removed from the Public Art Centre by September 30, 2023 (unless special arrangements are made) will become the property of the Public Art Centre.

ELIGIBILITY

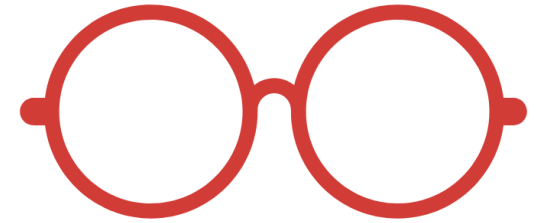
Any artist over 18 years who resides in Southwestern Ontario.
