

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN**  
**Meeting Minutes**

**January 27, 2020**

CALL TO ORDER: Sonny opened the meeting with the pledge at 7:05PM.

MINUTES:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the minutes for January 21. Gil **second**. Dottie brought up changing Scott's name to Gail's at the bottom of the minutes. **All** were in favor.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERKS:

- Lovedy Alexander, Research Club President, asked why the Board is now having people not use the room at the Municipal Building and the Board told her that it was because they would rather have people at the Brick Town Hall. She also asked if Rick the Custodian would set up the tables for the luncheon in March and Sonny told her that would not be a problem. Lovedy also asked who would take care of the trash, Sonny asked her what days the meetings were on and when he found out that they were on Tuesdays he said that Rick can take care of it on Wednesday. She also asked who would turn the heat on and was told that someone from the Research club would have to turn it on before the meeting.

- Wendy recused herself from voting on the snowplow contract because of a relative being one of the bidders. Sonny brought up that one of the bidders had brought in their bid after the cutoff time and he asked what the Board should do about that. Steve Malmude got up and said that the Board should consider the reason for the deadline. Howard Burnham said that if there is a specific time in the bid specifications then the bids that come in late should

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not be taken or considered. A towns person said that whatever the Board does should be in the best interest of the tax payer. Bill Jones got up and said that the Board is the ones who should make the decision. Gil **motioned** to accept the bids based on the time stated in the bid specifications. Joanne **second. All** were in favor. Sonny opened the bids, one bid was from Richardson Trucking which was for 2020-2021 it would be \$369,000, 2021-2022 \$385,000, and 2022-2023 \$395,000 and the second bid was from Richardson Excavation which is \$350,000 for all 3 years. Gil **motioned** to award the contract to Richardson Excavation. Dottie **second. Three** were in favor, Wendy recused herself, and Sonny did not raise his hand.

- Dottie **motioned** to approve the Selectmens Report. Sonny **second. All** were in favor.

WARRANT:

- Wendy **motioned** to approve the warrant as written. Dottie **second. All** were in favor.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Wendy read the announcements.

HEARING OF THE CITIZENS:

- Steve Malmude talked about the art exhibit on quilts up in the library and Cindy Smith made the comment that they are coming down on Friday morning.
- Steve McLean got up and reminded everyone about the get together that they are having for Dick McGlincey on February 2 from 1-3.

ADJOURN MEETING:

- Wendy **motioned** to adjourn. Gil **second. All** were in favor.
- The Meeting was adjourned at 7:35PM.
