

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING

May 16, 2016

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

ATTENDEES:

Roland LePage, Joanne Andrews, John Medici, Judy LePage, Cindy Smith, Michael McLean, Steve Malmude, Dottie Richard, Aaron Winn, Robert Pomerleau, Bob Richardson, Rick Richardson, Charles Pellegrino, and Ron Phinney.

CALL TO ORDER:

- Sonny called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

MINUTES:

- **Motion made and seconded** to approve Meeting Highlights of May 9th, 2016. All were in favor.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

- Aaron Winn asked the Board of Selectmen about the possibility of holding Martial Arts classes at the Brick Town Hall. The Board asked him to come back next week with insurance information.
- Robert Pomerleau, requested BOS to look at a deed from his attorney. Robert's attorney is requesting the Selectmen sign in order to include LAC lot numbers, not simply the Town Tax Map and Lot numbers. The Board decided to seek legal advice from the Town's attorney and would get back to Mr. Pomerleau. Robert purchased these lots at one of our auctions and is subsequently selling to another party. The lots were tax-acquired by the town of Limerick.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Cindy Smith gave her monthly report on activities happening in the library and the number of citizens that visited the library during the month of April. Cindy commented on the reception for the Artist of the Month, Carmen Sanchez. The Maine Wildlife Park pass was mentioned as being available, as well as passes for Willowbrook when it opens in July. Saturday, June 4th at 10:00 a.m., Cindy will be holding a children's workshop on making Fairy Houses. The library will be holding its annual book sale beginning Saturday, June 25th, 2016.
- Michael McLean read the Fire/EMS Report for the month of April. Michael spoke about recent training several firemen have taken. He reported that the Fire Dept. now has a Facebook page. Selectmen Medici asked Michael how old the current ambulance is and if he were in favor of purchasing a new ambulance. Chief McLean told about some of the electrical issues they recently had with the 11 year old ambulance and that, at this point, he does think it would be a good idea to purchase a new one.

- Judy informed the Board that the offices of Town Clerk/Tax Collector and Town Treasurer would be closed on Thursday, May 19th for the purpose of attending a workshop. Judy also told the Selectmen she was getting nervous because the Absentee Ballots had not arrived when they were supposed to and the stick for the voting machine was also missing.

OLD BUSINESS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to approve the 2014 Abatement for Suzanne Polcaro. Selectmen LePage and Medici were in favor. Joanne Andrews abstained from voting.
- Scott Nadeau was approved to repair pillars and clean outside basement windows to check for rot at the Municipal Building at a cost of \$750.00. No painting approved. **Motion made and seconded.** All were in favor.
- The Public Hearing for the fire truck/ambulance will be scheduled after the Fire Dept. gives the Selectmen the specifications on the ambulance.
- John gave a brief update on the vault. Approximately \$16,000 more in cost to attach it to the Municipal Building.
- Steve Malmude asked questions regarding the last paragraph of the engineer's report on the vault regarding the tension cables.

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to approve the BYOB Permit for the Route 11 Streakers on June 11th at the Brick Town Hall. All were in favor.
- **Motion made and seconded** to approve an application for Catering Permit by The Cornish Inn, serving alcohol at a private residence on Foss Road. All were in favor.
- Approved Diane Hamilton, Administrative Associate, to complete the US Census Bureau form on-line. **Motion made and seconded.** All were in favor.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Joanne read the Announcements.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- Sonny thanked Charles Pellegrino, Bob Richardson and Rick Richardson for the work they did installing the bench at the overlook. He told them how nice it came out. Sonny also thanked everyone who had made contributions.
- Sonny wanted to let Mike Welsh know how nice the steps were that he built at the back entrance to the Brick Town Hall.
- Charles Pellegrino, in turn, thanked everyone involved. He thanked all the donors of funds and materials since they helped make the bench project happen.
- Action, Pending or Bill Folders were approved. **Motion made and seconded.** All were in favor.

WARRANTS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the warrants as presented. Selectmen LePage and Andrews were in favor. Selectmen Medici was opposed.

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Steve Malmude had checked at the ballpark to see if the plexiglass had been installed at the playground. He is willing to install them.

- **Motion made and seconded** to adjourn the Meeting at 8:07 p.m. All were in favor.
