Job Summary

- Report to the CRWC Manager and Lead Operator
- Assist in operation of modern Class III Ultra-filtration and Reverse Osmosis treatment systems, a Class II community and regional water distribution system and five satellite reservoirs linked by SCADA control
- Conduct necessary daily water analysis to ensure Canadian drinking water quality guidelines and operational targets are met
- Participate in the work schedule in effect including on-call and response to after hour call-outs as required
- Able to work at other CRWC sites as directed

Education Requirements

- A minimum Grade 12 education is required. Two years of post-secondary education in a related field is beneficial and preferred
- A Class III Water Treatment and a Class II Water Distribution certification is preferred. Applicants with a lower or no certificates will be welcomed, provided they can aggressively or eagerly work to obtain required certifications at a pace determined by the Manager

Experience / Skills

- Mechanically inclined individuals experienced with tools and are willing to learn how to maintain, troubleshoot & repair water treatment equipment
- Comfortable around loud equipment.
- Strong willingness for continuous learning
- Self-motivated and enthusiastic
- Several years of operations experience in a Class II or higher water treatment facility would be an asset but not necessary
- Directly related experience in operation of an Ultra-filtration/Reverse Osmosis process would be an asset but also not necessary
- Excellent computer skills and familiarity with SCADA control and Microsoft Office programs are a definite asset

- Excellent interpersonal skills to assist with public inquiries and work with other employees
- Ability to work in a team manner or with a minimum of supervision or alone. Be available to respond to after-hours alarm call-outs
